### **Rules and Regulations**

for the implementation of a pro-quality remuneration system for academic teachers under the "Excellence Initiative - Research University" (IDUB) programme - "Bonus for publications" motivational allowance

## § 1 General Provisions

- 1. These Rules and Regulations define the rules for implementing a pro-quality remuneration system for academic teachers within the "Excellence Initiative Research University" programme (hereinafter: IDUB) through a motivational allowance, "Bonus for publication" (hereinafter: Bonus), for individuals with particularly high-quality publication activity.
- 2. Whenever these Rules and Regulations refer to:
  - 1) Minister's Communication, it shall be as the Communication of the Minister of Science of January 5, 2024, regarding the list of scientific journals and peer-reviewed materials from international conferences in relation to scientific publications, and the Communication of the Minister of Education and Science of July 22, 2021, regarding the list of publishers of peer-reviewed scientific monographs in relation to monographs.
  - 2) Scopus, it shall be understood as the online, multidisciplinary database of the publisher Elsevier, which is the mandatory reference database providing information on bibliometric indicators within the IDUB programme.
  - 3) TOP1, it shall be understood as journals which, in the list prepared according to the SCOPUS database as of July 1, 2025, are classified in the top centile of the most cited in the world in their fields.
  - 4) Co-authors from UWr, it shall be understood as co-authors of a publication who, at the time of submitting the application for the Bonus, have the status of being eligible to apply for it, i.e., they meet the conditions specified in sections 4 and 5.
  - 5) Publication from January 1 to June 30, 2025, it shall be understood as the actual date of issue of the journal number.
- 3. Bonuses for publications are intended to be an instrument motivating academic teachers and doctoral students of the University of Wrocław to engage in publication activity at the highest global level.
- 4. The following may apply for the Bonus:
  - 1) an academic teacher who is an employee of UWr on the day of submitting the application for the Bonus, provided that the publication is affiliated with UWr,
  - 2) a doctoral student participating in a doctoral school, provided that the publication is affiliated with UWr.
- 5. An academic teacher against whom a disciplinary penalty has been imposed, which has not yet been expunged, may not apply for the Bonus.
- 6. The Bonus is granted for:
  - 1) scientific publications published between January 1 and June 30, 2025, which are affiliated with the University of Wrocław and are included in the database of scientific publications of the employees of the University of Wrocław on the day of submitting the Bonus application, in accordance with the point values for individual disciplines adopted in § 3 section 6 of the competition Rules and Regulations.

- 2) scientific publications related to the "computer science" discipline, published between January 1 and June 30, 2025, which jointly meet the following conditions:
  - a. have a value of 200 or 140 points according to the Minister's Communication,
  - are affiliated with the University of Wrocław and are in the database of scientific publications of the employees of the University of Wrocław on the day of submitting the Bonus application,
  - c. are indexed in the DBLP database,
  - d. were published as a result of participation in an international conference that was assigned category A\* in the CORE ranking in the year of publication.
- 3) authorship of scientific monographs, published between January 1 and June 30, 2025, which jointly meet the following conditions:
  - a. are related to the scientific disciplines of the University of Wrocław,
  - b. were published by prestigious publishers from the second level of the list compliant with the Minister's Communication,
  - c. are affiliated with the University of Wrocław and are in the database of scientific publications of the employees of the University of Wrocław on the day of submitting the Bonus application.
- 7. The Bonus is not available to the Laureates of the competition "The best among the best in the search for teaching excellence" under task 11 of IDUB for publications that formed the basis for receiving the award.

# § 2 Conditions for Receiving the Bonus for a Publication

- 1. Applications for the competition should be submitted via the form to the address indicated in the Rector's announcement. The form includes the applicant's declaration that the information provided is factually correct and their consent to the processing of personal data.
- 2. The application form template is specified in **Appendix No. 1** to these Rules and Regulations.
- 3. The competition schedule is announced in the Rector's communication.
- 4. The condition for receiving the Bonus is a positive evaluation of the application, conducted by the IDUB Office based on the Evaluation Sheet, which constitutes **Appendix No. 2** to these Rules and Regulations.
- 5. The condition for receiving the Bonus by applicants and Co-authors from UWr is that they maintain their eligibility status and remain employed at UWr or have the status of a doctoral student at the time of the Bonus payment, as specified in the Rector's Communication announcing the competition.

# § 3 Rules for Awarding the Bonus for a Publication

1. A positive evaluation of the application results in the IDUB Office submitting a nominal list of persons entitled to receive the Bonus to the Human Resources Department.

- 2. In the case of a negative evaluation, the Applicant receives an evaluation sheet containing a detailed justification.
- 3. Bonuses for academic teachers are paid out as one-time motivational allowances in accordance with the remuneration rules in force at UWr.
- 4. Bonuses for doctoral students are paid out in the form of one-time supplements to their scholarship.
- 5. The bonus for the authorship of a monograph, as referred to in §1 section 6 point 3, is PLN 7,500 gross. The list of disciplines constitutes **Appendix No. 3** to these Rules and Regulations.
- 6. The Bonus for a publication is calculated as follows:

7. In the case of a publication in journals with 100, 140, or 200 points, indexed in TOP1 SCOPUS, the list of which constitutes **Appendix No. 4** to these Rules and Regulations, the awarded Bonus is increased by PLN 1,000 gross.

- 8. In the case of a single author/Co-author from UWr, they receive the full Bonus, whereas in the case of a larger number of Co-authors from UWr, the Bonus is divided proportionally, on an equal basis, among the Co-authors from UWr.
- 9. Each UWr employee may submit a maximum of two publications in one application in which they are an author or co-author, qualifying for the Bonus. At the same time, they may also receive a partial Bonus for other publications of which they are a co-author, submitted in the applications of other UWr employees in accordance with the rules set out in section 8.

# § 4 Final Provisions

- 1. All personal data provided by the Applicants are processed and stored for the needs of the competition in accordance with applicable regulations and are protected.
- 2. Information regarding the processing of personal data for persons participating in the competition constitutes Appendix No. 5 to these Rules and Regulations.

In accordance with Art. 13 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter "GDPR"), please be advised that:

- 3. Your personal data will be processed by the University of Wrocław:
  - on the basis of Art. 6(1)(a) of the GDPR, i.e., the consent you have given, for the purposes of conducting the Competition, including the publication of the Competition results on the IDUB project website;
  - 2) on the basis of Art. 6(1)(c) of the GDPR, in order to fulfill legal obligations in connection with the results of the Competition.
- 4. Your data may be disclosed only to public authorities or entities authorized to obtain data on the basis of applicable law and to entities with which the University has concluded appropriate data processing agreements, as well as disclosed on the IDUB project website on the basis of your consent.
