

Information Clause

Pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 (General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR), the University of Wrocław informs that:

- 1. The Controller of your personal data is the University of Wrocław, pl. Uniwersytecki 1, 50-137 Wrocław.
- 2. The Controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer, who can be contacted at: IOD@uwr.edu.pl
- 3. Your personal data will be processed under Article 6(1)(b) GDPR for the purpose of:
 - a) taking steps at your request prior to entering into a contract, i.e. considering your application for a place/room in a hall of residence, b) if granted and used – for the performance of the contract, the subject matter of which is the use of a place/room in a hall of residence. Providing your data is voluntary but necessary for the consideration of the application and, in the case of a granted place/room, for the

performance of the contract.

- 4. Furthermore, your personal data including: first name, surname, PESEL number, gender, date of birth, type of studies, faculty, permanent address, registered address, telephone number and e-mail address will be processed for:
 - a) conducting proceedings for the granting of social benefits in the form of a place in a hall of residence, pursuant to Article 104 of the Law on Higher Education and Science and § 33(3) of Ordinance No. 196/2023 of the Rector of the University of Wrocław of 25 March 2023 introducing the Regulations on Student Benefits at the University of Wrocław (Article 6(1)(c) GDPR),
 - b) archival and statistical purposes (Article 6(1)(c) GDPR),
 - c) in the case of applications submitted with a disability certificate or other relevant documentation Article 9(2)(b) and (j) GDPR,
 - d) processing of gender data Article 9(2)(b) GDPR.
- 5. Data will not be disclosed to external entities except as required by law or by contracts of the University of Wrocław.
- 6. You have the right to access, rectify, erase, restrict processing, portability, and to object to processing under GDPR.
- 7. Data will not be transferred outside the European Economic Area (EEA).
- 8. Data will not be subject to automated decision-making, including profiling.

- 9. Data will be stored for:
 - the limitation period for claims arising from accommodation in a hall of residence (if granted),
 - the limitation period for claims arising from applying for a place (if refused).
- 10. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office if you consider that the processing of your data violates GDPR.
