

ORDINANCE No. 22/2026
of the Rector of the University of Wrocław
of 17 February 2026

amending ordinance No. 196/2023 of the Rector of the University of Wrocław
of 25 June 2023 on introducing Regulations on benefits for students of the
University of Wrocław

Pursuant to Article 23, sections 1 and 2, Article 86 and Article 95 of the Act of 20 July 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), it is hereby resolved as stated:

§ 1. *The Regulations on benefits for students of the University of Wrocław, constituting an Appendix to the Ordinance No. 196/2023 of the Rector of the University of Wrocław of 25 August 2023 (as amended), are amended as follows:*

1) in § 3, section 4 shall be read:

“4) have a temporary residence permit in connection with the circumstances referred to in Article 151(1) or Article 151b(1) of the Act on Foreigners of 12 December 2013, or are residing on the territory of the Republic of Poland in connection with the exercise of short-term mobility of a scientist under the conditions set out in Article 156b(1) of the *Law on Higher Education and Science*, or have a national visa for the purpose of scientific research or development work;”;

2) in § 29, section 3 shall be read:

“3. The Dean/Vice-Dean makes the suggested ranking lists, each broken down into individual degree programmes and according to the principles referred to in § 25 section 2. The ranking lists include the students who have met the criteria laid down in § 24 section 7 along with the numbers of the Student Record Books [index]. If a student meets more than one criterion, the Dean/Vice-Dean places the student on only one ranking list.”;

3) in § 31, section 3 shall be read:

“3. The amount of the Rector's scholarship for:

- 1) outstanding academic performance may be differentiated according to grade point average;
- 2) having academic achievements, artistic achievements or sporting achievements in competition at least at national level shall be set at a single amount for all students;
- 3) being a laureate of an international olympics or a laureate or finalist of a central-level olympics referred to in the regulations on the educational system or being a medallist in at least a sports competition for the title of Champion of Poland in a given sport referred to in the regulations on sport is determined in one amount for all students taken over in the first year of studies in the year of taking the matriculation examination.”.

§ 2. The supervision of the performance of this Ordinance is entrusted to the Vice-Rector for Student Affairs.

§ 3. The Ordinance enters into force on the day of signature, with effect from 1 October 2019.
