# About the city



Wrocław is the economic, cultural and intellectual capital of Lower Silesia and the 4th largest city in Poland. It boasts fascinating architecture and a lively metropolitan cultural scene. Wrocław is situated to the north of the Sudety Mountains. It is close to both Germany and the Czech Republic. Odra river and its many tributaries and canals cut right through it creating 12 islands and 111 bridges.

Wrocław is one of the largest university centers in the country. The city's intellectual life is focused around 13 academic schools such as the University of Wrocław, Wrocław University of Science and Technology, and Wrocław University of Economics.

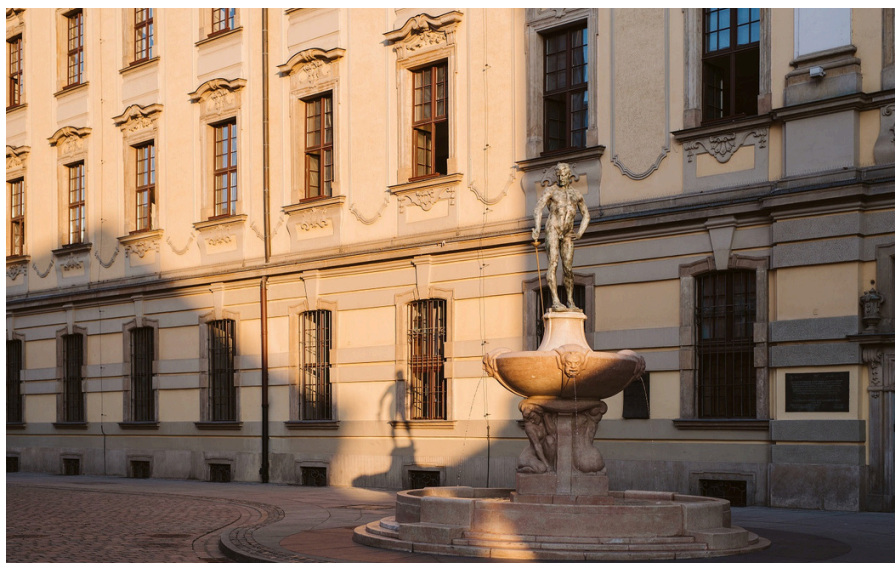
Wrocław is also a business-friendly city. The city's favourable location at the crossroads of European transport routes and its attractive infrastructure, which has lately been expanded with the Regional Business Tourism Centre, attract academic and business conferences and congresses.

# About the University of Wroclaw



The University of Wroclaw is one of the oldest universities in Central Europe, operating since 1702. Its identity was shaped by the historical heritage of Silesia and the influence of Austrian, Prussian, Czech and Polish cultures. The university also continues the academic traditions of Lviv and Vilnius Universities.

## Wroclaw University Library



There are more than 4.200.000 volumes together in Wroclaw University Library and its departmental libraries.

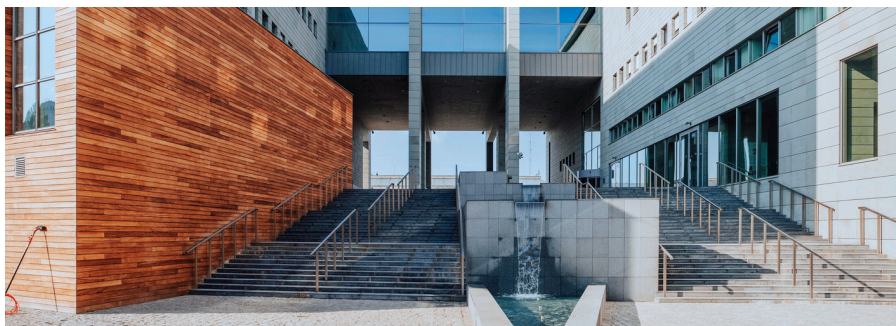
- Books: more than 1 453 457 volumes.
- Journals: more than 429 212 volumes/units.
- Special collections: more than 500.000 volumes/units including: 407 304 units, 44 712 microfilms, 60 277 units of restricted collections (uncataloged).
- Restricted collections: more than 169 000 (uncataloged) volumes.
- Departmental libraries collections: more than 1.700.000 volumes including over: 13.000 units of uncataloged collections.

The library consists of:

- collections of the pre-war City Library and University Library - as parts of it burned down, in accordance with the war reparation agreement about 211.917 books were brought back,
- minor, incomplete collections including Piast Library from Brzeg, Prince Jerzy Rudolf library from Legnica, Jesuit college library from Klodzko, parts of the Milich library from Zgorzelec, St. Peter and St. Paul's Church library from Legnica, a Cistercian library from Trzebnica, and also some well-protected parts of many other Lower Silesian libraries,
- very old collection known as "Bibliotheca Vetus", and a collection of gifts acquired on the basis of the bishop Carl Francis Neander testament,
- the Wrocław patrician Thomas Rediger Collection - Thomas Rediger donated his books to the city in his last will,
- St Mary Magdalene church library, based mostly on Jan Hess' (died in 1547) legacy,
- St Bernard church library whose beginnings are counted from 1502.

# Public transport

You can buy tickets in special machines which you can find at some of the bus and tram stops (you can pay by cash or card and will receive paper ticket). After entering the bus or the tram with a paper ticket you must validate it.

You can also buy a ticket inside every tram or bus (only pay-pass/proximity payments by card) - the ticket will be saved on your card and automatically validated, you won't get a paper one.



You might also want to use popular transportation applications such as Uber, Bolt or FreeNow to move around the city or a JakDojade app that contains the timetables for all the tram and buses lines as well as helps you find the right line for you to use and the right stop to wait at.
