

**RULES FOR ACCOMMODATION AT THE UNIVERSITY OF WROCLAW FOR THE HOLIDAY
PERIOD IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025/2026**

1. All residents of dormitories may stay in their dormitory until July 9 of this year without the need to submit additional applications.
2. Persons who are residents of dormitories as of April 30, 2026, who, for justified reasons, intend to stay in a dormitory during the holiday period are required to submit an application along with a justification via the USOS system between May 20 and May 31, 2026.

The Student Affairs Department will forward to the administrations of the dormitories a list of persons who have submitted applications for accommodation during the holiday period via the USOS system.

The dormitory manager will verify the list, in particular with regard to identifying persons for whom there are remarks concerning their stay in the dormitory, including any outstanding payments or other obligations to the dormitory.

By June 5 of this year, the dormitory manager will forward to the Student Affairs Department the verified list along with remarks concerning individual residents

3. Those who receive approval to stay in the dormitory during the holiday period may stay in the dormitories, provided they have no outstanding obligations to the dormitory as of June 30, 2026.
4. Residents staying in the dormitories during the summer are obliged to comply with the internal arrangements set by the dormitories managers.

Due to the necessity of conducting cleaning and maintenance work, they may be asked to:

- change rooms/places/floors (on short notice),
- provide access to the occupied room/module (for repairs, inventory, etc.),
- leave the dormitory during pest control activities (for several hours).

5. Residents staying in the dormitories acknowledge that they may not be able to remain in their currently occupied room and that single rooms may not be available during this period.

6. Residents are obliged to maintain cleanliness in their rooms and other common areas.
7. Residents must pay the accommodation fee in advance, by the 5th day of each month.
8. During the summer period, overnight guests are not allowed in student rooms. Guests may stay overnight only in rooms designated by the dormitory administration.
9. Residents applying for an extension of accommodation in the dormitories are aware of potential inconveniences associated with the planned renovation, such as noise, partial building closures, possible temporary lack of access to utilities, etc.
10. Failure to comply with the above rules will result in the loss of accommodation in dormitory.
11. During the holidays, the holiday price list for accommodation in the dormitory applies.
